



Canadian Tire Jumpstart® is a community-based charitable program that helps kids aged 4-18 participate in organized sports and recreation such as hockey, dance, soccer and swimming, so they can develop important life skills, self esteem and confidence.

National in scope but local in focus, Canadian Tire Jumpstart® delivers support to children in financial need through a Canadian-wide network of local chapters. These chapters are made up of a variety of community leaders committed to helping kids get active, such as Boys & Girls Club, Big Brothers and Big Sisters Canada, YMCA, and Parks and Recreation. The Boys & Girls Clubs of Kawartha Lakes is the local chapter for the City of Kawartha Lakes.

To date, there are 299 Canadian Tire Jumpstart® chapters in communities across the country. Since its launch in February 2005, Canadian Tire Jumpstart® has helped give more than 225,000 kids in financial need the chance to play. General Information:

- Submissions are accepted twice per year: January 15 to June 15 & July 1 to November 15
- Participants can access funding once per submission period and for 1 activity per child
- Maximum funding per participant per submission is \$300 but average is \$100 per child
- Average is \$100 so that more participants can receive financial assistance to participate

Application Process:

- Register your child with the program agency that he or she will be participating with
- Let program agency know that you will be applying for Canadian Tire Jump Start
- Submit child's program registration form, jumpstart application form, proof of gross family income or endorsement letter to Boys & Girls Clubs of Kawartha Lakes located at 107 Lindsay Street South, Lindsay, ON K9V 2M5 or by fax (705) 878-8605
- Ensure program registration form includes child's name, age, date of birth, activity, program duration, program hours per week, parent or guardian contact information, registration fees and address and who Canadian Tire Jump Start should make payment to
- Next step is the Boys & Girls Club of Kawartha Lakes submits your submission to Canadian Tire Jump Start program directly only on **Fridays**
- Canadian Tire Jump Start program pays the registration fees directly to program agency in approximately 4-6 weeks
