Canadian Tire Jumpstart® is a community-based charitable program that helps kids aged **4-18** participate in organized sports and recreation such as hockey, dance, gymnastics, soccer and swimming, so they can develop important life skills, self-esteem and confidence. National in scope but local in focus, Canadian Tire Jumpstart® delivers support to children in financial need through a Canadian-wide network of local chapters. The Boys & Girls Clubs of Kawartha Lakes is one of three local chapters that processes applications for Boys and Girls Club programs and community sports and recreation programs. Lindsay Gymnastics is also a chapter and processes applications for their gymnastics programs. The City of Kawartha Lakes Parks & Recreation is also a chapter and processes applications for their programs. Applications for Lindsay Gymnastics or City of Kawartha Lakes Parks & Recreation programs must be submitted directly to them.

#### **General Information:**

- Applications are accepted twice per year: January 15 to June 15 & July 1 to November 15
- Participants can apply for funding in each application period
- Maximum funding per participant per application is \$300 but average is \$100 per child
- Average is \$100 so that more participants can receive financial assistance to participate

#### **To apply for Canadian Tire Jumpstart Financial Assistance the following steps are required:**

- Step 1** - Complete Canadian Tire Jumpstart Application form for each child requiring financial assistance (Application form available as pdf download at [www.bgckl.com](http://www.bgckl.com) or from office)
- Step 2** – Ensure application section 2 is filled out with details of program requiring financial assistance for and ensure includes contact name, phone number and email address
- Step 3** – Attach activity registration form or receipt for each child to your application
- Step 4** – Ensure application section 3 is endorsed by someone who can verify your need for financial assistance or attach proof of gross family income (Pay Stub or Tax Return)
- Step 5** – Check off that application for Canadian Tire Jumpstart Assistance is complete by checking off all steps above and then sign and date at the bottom of this page
- Step 6** - Submit completed application for Boys & Girls Club or community programs in person to Boys & Girls Clubs of Kawartha Lakes at 107 Lindsay Street South, Lindsay, ON K9V 2M5 or by Fax at 705-878-8605 (Incomplete applications will not be accepted or able to be processed)
